5. Find the name of one community group who helped students work toward successful integration.
6. Find two differences between Stephens-Lee High School and Lee Edwards High School in Asheville.
7. What did the acronym ASCORE stand for?

9. Find at least two names of adults who helped ASCORE students accomplish their goals.
